Sexual exploitation is child abuse and involves victims being groomed by their abusers.

Things we can all look out for:

- changes in behaviour
- regularly coming home late or going missing overnight
- excessive/concealed phone or internet usage
- associating with unknown adults
- low school attendance
- becoming isolated from friends and family
- unexplained money or gifts



We all have a duty to protect vulnerable children
